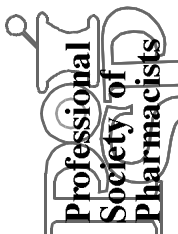

Speakers

Dr. Ali Olyaei is Professor of Pharmacy Practice and Medicine, Division of Nephrology and Hypertension and also a chemical pharmacotherapist at OSU/OHSU. He has written extensively in the area of drug safety in renal and liver failure and pharmacology of new drugs. He also has undertaken collaborative research in hypertension and chronic kidney disease.

Dr. Mark Crislip is the medical director for Legacy Infection Control Program and an editor for the *Science Based Magazine* blog. He publishes the *Quackcast* podcast, winner of the 2009 Best Health Podcast, and *Pusscast*, a biweekly update of infectious disease literature.

Dr. Robert Tibolt is an ophthalmologist in practice in Salem and Portland. He is a clinical eye instructor at the Casey Eye Institute and OHSU, and is currently on active staff at many local hospitals.

Dr. Mark Della Paolera is an Assistant Professor at Pacific University School of Pharmacy. He teaches Pharmacy Practice, Immunology, and Pulmonology and has several years of experience in retail, hospital, and ambulatory care pharmacy practice.

Dr. Arup Indra is an Associate Professor at the Department of Pharmaceutical Sciences at OSU College of Pharmacy. He is a member of the Knight Cancer Institute, Department of Dermatology, OHSU and the Environmental Health Science Center. He has extensive experience in research in skin development, diseases, and cancer.

Dr. Bridget Bradley is an Assistant Professor of Pharmacy at Pacific University School of Pharmacy. The majority of her teaching is during the second year of the curriculum with an emphasis on mental health topics. She is a graduate of OSU and has completed residencies at the Roseburg VA and the Avera Behavioral Health Center in Sioux Falls, South Dakota.
